ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS, RELEASE, CERTIFICATIONS, AND SIGNATURE AGREEMENT

I. Certification of Understanding and Agreement

By executing this application and agreement, I, the undersigned contestant (“Contestant”), certify that I have read, fully understand, and agree to be bound by:

- The Official 2027 Miss Rodeo Oregon Inc. Foundation Pageant Rulebook.
- The 2027 Miss Rodeo Oregon Performance Contract
- All programs, activities, and functions associated with the Miss Rodeo Oregon Pageant

I acknowledge that Miss Rodeo Oregon, Inc. Foundation and related entities will rely upon my execution of this agreement in permitting my participation.

II. Release, Waiver of Liability, and Assumption of Risk

Contestant hereby **RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES, HOLDS HARMLESS, AND AGREES TO INDEMNIFY** Miss Rodeo Oregon Inc. Foundation, the Miss Rodeo Oregon Pageant, The Elgin Stampede, and their respective officers, directors, employees, agents, members, volunteers, contractors, sponsors (commercial and private), representatives, and affiliates (“Released Parties”) from any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, liabilities, damages, losses, costs, and expenses (including attorney’s fees), whether known or unknown, fixed or contingent, arising out of or relating to:

1. Participation in Pageant Activities

Participation in any events, programs, activities, or functions associated with the Miss Rodeo Oregon Pageant, including but not limited to rodeos, equestrian events, parades, public appearances, travel, and use of facilities, arenas, premises, or equipment.

2. Inherent Risks of Equestrian and Rodeo Activities

Contestant acknowledges that equestrian and rodeo activities are inherently dangerous and may result in serious bodily injury, permanent disability, death, or property damage.

Risks include, but are not limited to:

- The unpredictable behavior or temperament of horses
- Hazards posed by other participants, spectators, animals, equipment, or environmental conditions
- The conduct or decisions of third parties

Contestant knowingly and voluntarily assumes **all risks**, whether foreseen or unforeseen, known or unknown.

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3. **No Guarantee of Safety**

Contestant acknowledges that the Released Parties cannot and do not guarantee the safety or wellbeing of any participant.

III. **Indemnification**

Contestant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against all claims arising from:

- Personal injury, illness, or death to Contestant, her horse, or third parties
- Property damage or loss
- Claims arising from Contestant's conduct, horse, or equipment
- Costs incurred in defense of such claims

IV. **Responsibility for Horse and Equipment**

Contestant acknowledges sole responsibility for the care, condition, behavior, and control of her horse and all equipment used during participation.

V. **Grant of Permissions and Media Release**

Contestant grants permission to the Released Parties to:

1. **Verify Information**

Verify all information provided and obtain records reasonably necessary for verification.

2. **Use of Likeness and Materials**

Use, reproduce, publish, distribute, and display:

- Photographs provided by or taken of Contestant
- Information provided or otherwise obtained

This authorization applies now and in the future, without compensation.

VI. **Eligibility Certifications**

Contestant certifies that:

- She is a natural-born female and identifies as female
- She has never been married, pregnant, a legal parent or is engaged to be married.
- She meets the age requirements as outlined in the 2027 Miss Rodeo Oregon Pageant Rulebook.
 - **Miss:** must be 21 years of age by November 1st, 2027 and no older than 26 years of age as of December 31st, 2027
 - **Teen:** will obtain the age of 15 years on or before December 31st, 2027 and will be no older than 19 years of age as of December 31, 2027.
 - **Junior:** will obtain the age of 11 years on or before December 31st, 2027 and will be no older than 14 years of age as of December 31st, 2027.

- **Little:** Must reach 7 years of age by July 1st, 2026 and be no older than 10 years as of December 31st, 2027
- She has proof of an Oregon address and residency for the 6 months prior to pageant. .
- She has never been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor, excluding minor traffic offenses.
- She has not engaged in any act that could reasonably harm their reputation or the goodwill of the Miss Rodeo Oregon Pageant.
- She is not a state titleholder of any other state or national pageant.

VII. Submission of Required Materials

Contestant agrees to submit:

- Non-Refundable Entry fee as outline in the Miss Rodeo Oregon Rulebook
- Proof of Age
- Proof of Oregon residency as outlined in the pageant rulebook
- One (1) vertical color 8x10 head-and-shoulders photograph as outlined in the pageant rulebook
- One (1) color 8x10 photograph of Contestant with her horse as outlined in the pageant rulebook
- Proof of horse ownership or lease agreement valid through the end of the titleholder's reign as outlined in the pageant rulebook.

VIII. Disqualification and Liquidated Damages

The certifications and authorizations in this agreement are continuing. Contestant agrees that:

1. Failure to meet or maintain eligibility, or failure to notify the Released Parties of changes, results in **automatic disqualification without notice**.
2. Upon disqualification, Contestant shall return all awards and pay liquidated damages equal to all monies or consideration received.
3. Contestant waives all claims for compensation, reimbursement, or damages.

IX. Titleholder Obligations

If selected as Miss Rodeo Oregon titleholder, Contestant agrees to:

1. Execute and comply with the 2027 Miss Rodeo Oregon Performance Contract.
2. Serve in accordance with organizational rules and promote the organization without compensation
3. Make designated public appearances
4. Return all perpetual title-related items upon naming of a successor

X. General Provisions

This agreement:

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- Is binding upon Contestant and her heirs, assigns, and legal representatives
- Is governed by the laws of the State of Oregon
- Shall be resolved exclusively in Union County, Oregon
